As the need and demand grows for the integration of climate change education in schools, the Summer Institute will help catalyze the preparation of K-5 teachers* to develop and lead lessons aligned with standards- and place-based learning.

A vital part of LEAP's education programming, the 2023 Summer Institute constitutes four full days of professional learning, bringing together faculty, doctoral students, expert teachers, and leaders from the NYC Department of Education to create a learning community that will explore, make sense of, and provide tangible support for incorporating climate change across different subject areas.

The 2023 Summer Institute is free.

Participants will receive a \$1,000 stipend, and may earn up to 28 CTLE credits.

* *Subsequent summers will focus on preparing middle and high school teachers.*
